BY- LAW #2015-053

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ON THE SHOULDER OF MUNICIPAL ROADS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HASTINGS HIGHLANDS.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O 2001 as amended, empowers a municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, Section 191.8 subsection (3), chapter H.8, as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws permitting the operation of off-road vehicles on any highway within the municipality that is under the jurisdiction of the municipality or on any part or parts of such highways and which by-laws may prescribe a lower rate of speed for off-road vehicles by regulation on any highway within the municipality that is under its jurisdiction, or any part or parts of such highway;

AND WHEREAS beginning July 1, 2015, the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, Ontario Regulation 135/15 further defines Off Road Vehicles and expands upon their permitted use;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HASTINGS HIGHLANDS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

I. DEFINITIONS

In this By-Law;

"All-Terrain Vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that,

- (a) Has four wheels, the tires of all of which are in contact with the ground,
- (b) Has steering handlebars,
- (c) Has a seat that is designed to be straddled by the driver, and
- (d) Is designed to carry,
 - i. a driver only and no passengers, or
 - ii. a driver and only one passenger, if the vehicle;

"Multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that,

- (a) Has four or more wheels, the tires of which are all in contact with the ground,
- (b) Has a steering wheel for steering control,
- (c) Has seats that are not designed to be straddled, and
- (d) Has a minimum cargo capacity of 159 kilograms;

"Recreational off-highway vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that,

(a) Has four or more wheels, the tires of which are all in contact with the ground,

I. PENALTIES

Any persons who contravene any section of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for under the Highway Traffic Act.

IV. EFFECTIVE

This By-Law # 2015-053 shall come into force and take effect on the day of its passing and shall remain in effect until otherwise amended or repealed.

V. REPEAL

By-Law 10-2004 is hereby repealed and rescinded.
