



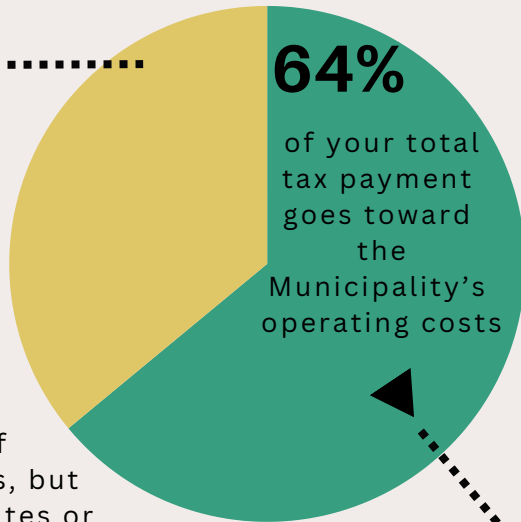
The Municipality is proposing to collect \$9,442,658 in property taxes for 2025.

The estimated tax rate increase for the average residential household is **4.69%**. This means in 2025, the average residential household (assessed at \$188,000) would see an estimated increase of approximately **\$77** for municipal taxes for the year.

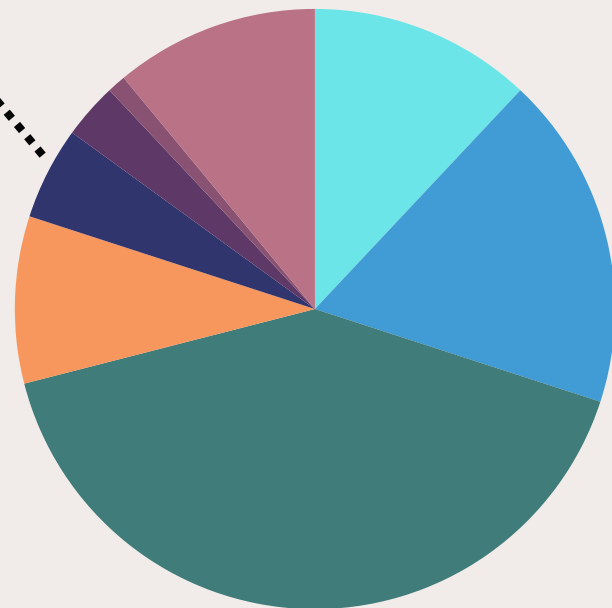
- General Government Services, 12%

How your tax bill is calculated ▼



Taxes are calculated by multiplying the assessed value of your property (determined by MPAC) by the current tax rate (set by the Municipality) for your property class. Total property assessment in Hastings Highlands exceeds \$1.1 billion.

Your taxes will be higher or lower depending on the assessed value of your home.
