

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HASTINGS HIGHLANDS  
BYLAW 2019-049**

**BEING A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE DISPOSAL OF WASTE AND THE OPERATION OF  
WASTE DISPOSAL AND TRANSFER SITES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HASTINGS HIGHLANDS**

---

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 11 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* as amended from time to time, Municipalities may pass bylaws respecting Waste Management;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 77 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* as amended from time to time, a Municipality may, in a bylaw prohibiting or regulating any matter passed under the 'Waste Management' sphere of jurisdiction, provide that a person who contravenes the bylaw is guilty of an offence;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it expedient to regulate the disposal of waste and the operation of Waste Disposal Sites and Waste Transfer Sites;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HASTINGS HIGHLANDS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;**

**1. APPLICATION**

This bylaw shall apply to all of the owners and occupants of property within the geographic limits of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

**2. DEFINITIONS**

In this bylaw,

'Ashes' shall mean the extinguished solid residue of any household fuel remaining after burning, including but not limited to ashes, soot, and other chimney deposits.

'Bag' shall mean a polyethylene clear plastic bag measuring not more than 76 \* 94 cm (30 \* 38 inches) closed at the top and securely fastened.

'Council' shall mean the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

'Hazardous waste' shall mean waste and materials as may be defined from time to time by the Ministry of the Environment Conservation and Parks "MECP" as hazardous and shall include but not be limited to the following: flammable or incendiary materials or liquids, incinerator ash, explosives, sewage, drugs and medicine, chemical wastes, dry cell or wet cell batteries, pathological waste including syringes, needles, dressings, body parts and fluids, tissues, medical instruments or other such items as may or could reasonable contain pathogenic bacteria or micro-organisms, dead

animals, motor oil, propane tanks, radioactive materials and other similar materials that may be hazardous or dangerous to the public health, safety or environment.

'ECA' shall mean the Environmental Compliance Approval issued by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.

'Household' shall mean a residential unit occupied or used as a place of abode other than an Industrial, Commercial or Institutional premise.

'Waste Site Attendant' shall mean an employee of the Municipality who is responsible for the operation of the Waste Disposal site or Waste Transfer site.

'The Ministry or MECP shall mean the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks being the controlling authority for the Municipality's Waste Disposal / Waste Transfer sites.

'Municipality' shall mean the Corporation of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

'Person' shall include individuals, corporations and partnerships.

'Recycling Depot' shall mean the area of the Waste Disposal Site or Waste Transfer Site where Recyclable Materials are deposited in appropriate containers.

'Recyclable Materials' shall mean such items as the municipality identifies as being suitable for recycling purpose.

'Resident' shall mean any person who is the owner, occupant or tenant of any property within the geographic limits of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

'Waste' shall mean all mineral and vegetable matter in any form or state abandoned, discarded or thrown out by any householder or generated from a residential property or dwelling, and includes non-recyclable household garbage, Recyclable Material, refuse, and domestic waste.

'Waste Disposal Pass' shall mean the identification card as provided by the Municipality to Residents from time to time.

'Waste Disposal site' shall mean location as set out in Schedule "A" to this bylaw, which is used solely for the purpose of disposing and/or recycling of waste refuse and waste

'Waste Transfer Site' shall mean locations as set out in Schedule "A".

### **3. LANDFILL SITE OPERATIONS**

- i. The Waste Disposal Sites and or Waste Transfer Site WDS/WTS shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of all applicable Provincial legislation and or approved Ministry plans for such sites.

- ii. The Waste Disposal Sites or Waste Transfer Site, WDS/WTS shall be open to the Residents of the Municipality only during approved MECP times as specified in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
- iii. No Waste will be accepted by the Waste Site Attendants other than from an owner or Resident of a property within the geographic limits of the Municipality, who is able to produce a Waste Disposal Pass as identification.
- iv. No waste will be accepted by the Waste Site Attendant from a commercial waste collector unless said collector is contracted or authorized by the Municipality.
- v. All waste and recyclable materials shall be deposited under the direction of the Waste Site Attendant.

#### **4. GARAGE AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS PICKUP**

- i. The Municipality may enter into contracts with any person or persons for household pickup, removal, transfer, processing, storage, reduction, reuse, recycling and/or disposal of Waste.

#### **5. RECYCLABLE MATERIALS**

All Recyclable Material shall be separated from non-recyclable Wastes and delivered to the Waste Site as set out in schedule "D" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

#### **6. PROHIBITIONS**

- i. No person shall enter onto Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site property other than during operating hours.
- ii. Notwithstanding clause (i) above, Municipal employee, consultants, contractors and other authorized persons shall have access to Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site as required.
- iii. No person shall salvage any materials from a Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site.
- iv. No person shall throw, place or deposit any type of waste on any roadway, highway or bridge or any municipally owned property that is outside of the limits of the waste Disposal Sites as set out in this Bylaw.
- v. No Person shall dispose of any of the following materials at a Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site:
  - Manufacturer's waste, oils, toxic liquids or semi-liquid waste
  - Derelict automobiles or any vehicle being air, ground or water.
  - Hauled sewage or feces from any source
  - Hazardous wastes
  - Fences, page wire (may be disposed of in the steel pile)
  - Any explosive or highly combustible materials of any nature whatsoever
  - Any other material as may be prohibited under the *Environmental Protection Act* section 2-General provisions, Part 5- Waste Management, Part 7- Abandoned Motor Vehicles, or Part 10- Spills.
- vi. No person shall create or cause to be created malicious damage to or at a Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site
- vii. No person shall dispose of any Waste without first paying the applicable tipping fee if required.

- viii. No person shall dispose of material containing loose asbestos fibers.
- ix. No person shall dispose of refrigerated appliances not bearing a certificate that the chlorofluorocarbons have removed by a licensed person/contractor.
- x. No person shall discharge a firearm in a Municipal Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site.

## **7. USER FEES**

Tipping fees are as set out in schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

## **8. GENERAL**

The Municipality shall not be liable to any person for any damage caused to any person or property or vehicle while at a Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site.

## **9. DISPOSAL OF WASTE OR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS OUTSIDE OF THE WASTE DISPOSAL SITE**

No person shall place any Waste or Recyclable Materials, Industrial Waste, Commercial Waste, goods, wares appliances, junk refuse or other material outside of the gates of any Municipal Waste Disposal Site / Waste Transfer Site.

## **10. SCHEDULES**

The following schedules annexed and attached to this bylaw shall form of this bylaw:

- iii. SCHEDULE "C" Hours of operation
- iv. SCHEDULE "D" Recyclable Material

## **11. PENALTIES**

Any person who contravenes any Section of the Bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction is liable to a fine of not more than five thousand (\$5,000) dollars and such fine shall be recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*.

## **12. REPEAL OF BYLAWS**

Bylaw 42-2005 Regulate the Disposal of Garbage and the Operation of Waste Disposal Sites is hereby repealed.

## **13. DATE BYLAW COMES INTO EFFECT**

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing.

**SCHEDULE "D"**  
**BLUE BOX RECYCLABLE MATERIALS**

**Items accepted for Waste Disposal/Waste Transfer recycling are:**

- **Aluminum** - foil, pop cans, pie plates.
- **Steel** - food and beverage cans and tins (soup, juice, etc.), empty aerosol cans.
- **Glass** - cleaned bottles and jars (clear or coloured with tops removed)
- **Plastic** - jars, bottles and containers with tops removed.
- **Poly Coated** - drinking boxes, milk and juice cartons.
- **Cardboard** - flattened boxes, pizza boxes, egg cartons, brown paper bags.
- **Paper** - writing paper, envelopes, books (**hard covers removed**), shredded paper in a clear bag only.
- **Newsprint** - newspapers, flyers, phone books, magazines, catalogues.

**NOTE: Any Polystyrene (Styrofoam) or film plastic is considering waste.**

**PLEASE ENSURE ITEMS ARE THOROUGHLY RINSED**

**Items considered Hazardous Waste and not accepted at the Waste Disposal/Waste Transfer site for recycling:**

**Automatic and Garage Products-** Antifreeze, transmission fluid, batteries and battery acid, gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, motor oil, auto waxes, automotive fluids, oil containers.

**Household Cleaning products-** Ammonia based, chlorine bleach, disinfectants, drain cleaning agents (acids and bases), oven cleaners, window cleaners

**Paints and Paint Related Materials-**Please DO NOT mix latex and oil based paints. Latex paint, oil based paint, furniture and print stripping agents, driveway sealers and roof patch, brush cleaners, primers, stains, varnishes, wood preservatives, linseed oil, wood stains, varsol and solvents

**Pesticides and Garden Products-** Flea collars and sprays, mothballs, roach and ant poisons, arsenicals, fungicides, fertilizers, insecticides, herbicides, molluscicides (snails & slug bait), rat and mouse poison

**Miscellaneous Products-** Aerosols (empty containers as well), thinners and turpentine, dry cell batteries (disposable and rechargeable), propane cylinders, BBQ lighter fluids, fluorescent light tubes and bulbs (unbroken), photographic chemicals, pharmaceuticals (medicines and expired prescriptions) nail polish & polish remover, thermometers, thermostats and switches, glues and adhesives, pool chemicals and bleach (DO NOT MIX)- please keep chemicals separate from other chemicals. Sharps-place in a rigid plastic container (needles only). Smoke detectors/co2 detectors.

**NOT ACCEPTED-** commercial, industrial or institutional wastes, radioactive materials, explosives, fireworks, ammunition, biological wastes, PCB wastes, helium or Freon tanks or unknown waste.
