CLERK'S DEPARTMENT

Council passed 'Bylaw 2020-074' being a Bylaw to authorize an agreement between the Municipality and the Maple Leaf Rally Club for the use of municipal roads during the Rally of the Tall Pines. This event is scheduled for November 21, 2020. **NO** spectators will be permitted this year due to COVID-19.



Council reviewed a copy of the draft policy for the 'Handling of Unreasonable Customer Behaviour'. Council will provide more direction to staff in collaboration with the review of the Customer Service Policy, which will be presented to Council in the near future.

ADMINISTRATION

Grant Murphy, Field Officer for the Loyalist Sector of the Office of the Fire Marshal, and Emergency Management, made a presentation to Council on the roles and responsibilities of the Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) position.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

The planning department continues to be busy and presented Council with two Zoning Bylaw Amendments, a Bylaw to accept the transfer of a road and Council's support for three severances.



OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

Council directed staff to include in the 2021 Budget the cost to purchase TC-400 Battery Powered Portable Radar Speed Signs, aimed at reducing excessive speed on Municipal roads.
