



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS – VOLUNTEER POSITION HASTINGS HIGHLANDS PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD MEMBER

“The Hastings Highlands Public Library strives to inspire lifelong learning, to advance knowledge and to strengthen our community”. The Board fills a governance role for the municipal library system as outlined in *The Public Libraries Act*; and to ensure that library programs, services and facilities meet the needs of the citizens in the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

To be on a public library board in Ontario you must be:

- a Canadian citizen
- a resident of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands
- at least 18 years of age
- not be employed by the Hastings Highlands Public Library or the Municipality of Hastings Highlands
- not be convicted of an indictable offence

Consideration for the following qualities would be an asset:

- Firm connections and affiliations with the community
- Prepared to devote an average of three (3) to six (6) hours per month
- Conviction that the Hastings Highlands Public Library is uniquely important to the life of the community
- Ability to approach problems and people with an open mind
- Ability and eagerness to deal with values, vision and the long-term mission of the library
- Committed to fiscally responsible management
- Possess initiative and courage to plan creatively and carry out plans effectively

The Hastings Highlands Public Library Board holds a minimum of seven (7) meetings per year. The Board term is concurrent with the Municipal council term of four years, which ends on November 14, 2022.
