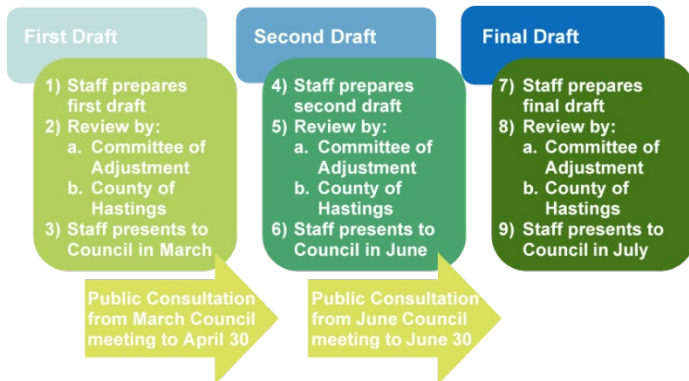
PLANNING DEPARTMENT

Council approved the amendments to the 'Public Engagement Strategy' for the 'Update of the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw'. The General Framework of the Strategy includes the reading of three drafts scheduled as follows:

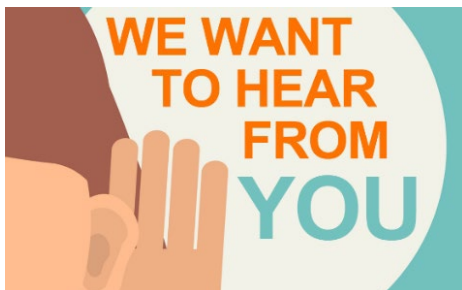
First Reading: March 31, 2021

Second Reading: June 2, 2021

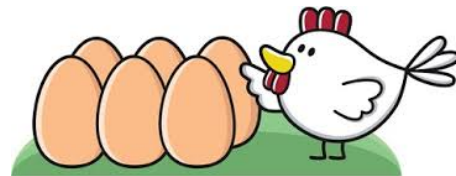
Third/Final Reading: July 21, 2021



The Municipality has proposed a 'Draft Shoreline and Tree Preservation Bylaw' and **WE WANT YOUR INPUT!** Visit our website for a copy of the Draft Bylaw, a list of FAQs and to submit your input. Deadline to submit is April 30, 2021.



Council directed staff to prepare a Draft Bylaw to allow backyard hens (8 maximum) for meat (once a year for their life span of 0-9 weeks) and/or eggs on a minimal lot size of 1 acre.



Council gave tentative approval for the sale and closure of two Original Shoreline Road Allowances.

WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING – March 3, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.

The Waste Management Committee approved the 'Hastings Highlands Poster Contest – Keep Hastings Highlands Beautiful with the 7R's of Waste Management: Rethink, Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Repair and Rot.
