#### FINANCE DEPARTMENT

Council accepted the Quarterly Treasury Report (Q4) as prepared by the Deputy Treasurer. A copy of this report will be available on the Municipal Website under Financial Information→Budget Information.



#### REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES

**Municipal Fire Task Force Ad Hoc Committee:** Council voted in support of the Municipal Fire Task Force Ad Hoc Committee’s recommendation to investigate the potential of decommissioning of Fire Station 2.



#### CLERK’S DEPARTMENT

Council reviewed for information the ‘2018 Post-Election Accessibility Report’ as prepared by the Clerk’s Department. This report addressed the prevention and removal of barriers in preparation for the 2022 Municipal and School Board Election.



Council has directed staff to leave Station 5 ‘status quo’ for a period of one year for the purpose of budgeting, investigation and possible rebuild.

**Waste Management Committee:** Council voted in support of the Waste Management Committee’s recommendation to have the remaining members of Council tour Hastings Highlands’ nine (9) waste sites. The Waste Management Committee has completed this tour with the Operations Manager and found the information and site visits to be invaluable.

Council voted in favour of a motion directing staff to ‘Request professional legal advice on Hastings County’s Exotic Animal Bylaw Template.’
