CLERK'S DEPARTMENT

Council passed their new Procedure Bylaw (2021-018) being a bylaw to govern the calling, place, and proceedings of meetings. To view a copy of the Municipality's Procedure Bylaw visit:

Council approved the '[2020 Remuneration and Expenses](#)' report submitted by the Financial Analyst-Payables for information. This report contains an itemized statement detailing the remuneration and expenses paid in 2020 for each member of Council.



MOTIONS (for Which Notice Has Been Given)

Council voted in favour of a motion directing staff to send a letter, along with the staff report '*Cost Evaluation to Complete Hastings Highlands Road 62*' to the Canadian Minister of Infrastructure and Communities, the Ontario Minister of Infrastructure as well as to the local M.P, M.P.P and County of Hastings Warden requesting immediate financial support to proceed with the revitalization of Hastings Highlands Road 62 (formerly Provincial Highway 62).



FINANCE DEPARTMENT

Council approved the '2021 Draft Operating Budget' as presented by the Deputy Treasurer. Council directed staff to bring the 'Draft Operating Budget' to the Regular Meeting of Council on April 21, 2021 for final approval.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

Council reviewed the 'Draft Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw' as presented by the Municipal Planner. Public input is being is now being received for this bylaw and can be submitted in any of the following ways:
