#### CLERK'S DEPARTMENT

Council passed Bylaw '2021-029 Council Vacancy Policy' being a bylaw to adopt a policy when the seat of a Member of Council becomes vacant. A copy of this policy is available on our website at [www.hastingshighlands.ca](http://www.hastingshighlands.ca) → Council/Committees



Council accepted the report "Method to Fill the Vacant Council (Mayoral) Seat" as prepared by the Clerk. Council chose to fill the vacant seat of the Mayor by appointment of any Member of Council wishing to be considered. Council will vote on this appointment at a Special Meeting of Council to be held May 12, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.

#### PLANNING DEPARTMENT

Council passed Bylaw 2021-036 being a bylaw to accept a road transfer to fulfill a condition of severance.

Council passed Bylaw 2021-031 to declare Municipal Properties on Y Road as Surplus Land.

Council granted tentative approval of two (2) shore road allowance closures and sales.

#### MOTION(S) (For Which Motions Have Been Given)

Council directed Operations staff to install two (2) 'Turtle Crossing' signs (one in each direction), at the causeway on South Baptiste Lake Road, at their earliest convenience.
