APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MAYORAL SEAT

Council cast their ballots in favour of the candidate they wished to appoint as Deputy Mayor of Hastings Highlands. Councillor Gerrow was the successful candidate. Deputy Mayor-Appoint Gerrow will take her Declaration of Office at the June 16, 2021, Regular Meeting of Council.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

Council reviewed, for second reading, the Municipality's Draft Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw. The Municipality is required under the Ontario *Planning Act* to amend the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw to conform with the Official Plan (within 3 years) which was passed by Hastings County in August 2018. Senior Planner Jason Budd from Hastings County was present for the meeting.

- The third and final reading of the Draft Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw will be on July 21, 2021.
- Public input on the Draft Bylaw will be received up until July 21, 2021. Visit 'Have Your Say Hastings Highlands!' webpage for a list of options on how you can submit your input.

Council passed three (3) Bylaws to amend the zone of three properties.

Council commented on two (2) severance applications, submitted by Hastings County Planning for review by Council.

Motions (for Which Notice Has Been Given)

Staff was directed to write a resolution in support of the creation of a designated 3-digit suicide hotline # 988, with a copy of the resolution to go to Daryl Kramp our MPP, Derek Sloan our current Federal MP, Federal Minister of Health Patty Hajdu, the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications (CRTC) and all municipalities in Ontario.

SUICIDE HOTLINE

Council directed staff to contact the County of Hastings to obtain professional advice and support for a pathway moving forward on the following items:

- Education on shoreline health for Hastings Highlands Council, Staff and Residents
- Assistance with preparation of a one-page information sheet that would be provided to contractors and real estate agents on existing regulations for maintaining shoreline health (for example silt fencing and 30 metre buffer zone etc.).
