



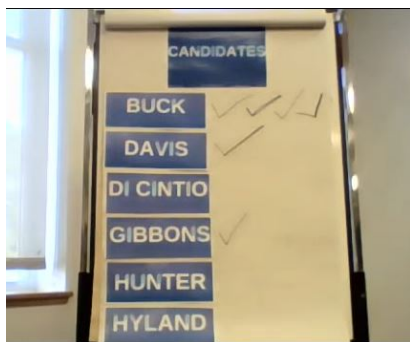

APPOINTMENT OF A COMMUNITY MEMBER TO THE VACANT COUNCILLOR SEAT

At today's Regular Meeting of Council, Council completed interviews and cast their ballots in favour of the candidate they wished to appoint to the vacant seat of Councillor. **Keith Buck** is the successful candidate. Keith will take his Declaration of Office at the August 11, 2021, Special Meeting of Council. Congratulations Keith!



COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BYLAW 2021-021 (Third and Final Reading)

Council passed Bylaw 2021-021 Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw being a bylaw to amend Bylaw 2004-035 Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw to conform with the County of Hastings Official Plan and additional administrative amendments. The Municipality was required under the *Ontario Planning Act* to amend the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw to conform with the Official Plan (within 3 years) which was passed by Hastings County in August 2018.

2021 MISCELLANEOUS GRANT PROGRAM

Council reviewed the information contained within the Miscellaneous Grant Applications received as part of the 2021 Miscellaneous Grant Program and directed staff to invite applicants to present a delegation to Council at an upcoming Council Meeting with the funds being allocated at the same meeting.

HASTINGS HIGHLANDS FIRE DEPARTMENT DRAFT MASTER FIRE PLAN (Second Reading)



Council reviewed the Hastings Highlands Fire Department Draft Master Plan for second reading. The final reading of the Plan will come to the September 15, 2021 meeting. DRAFT EXOTIC ANIMAL BYLAW

Council reviewed for second reading the 'Draft Bylaw 2021-037 Exotic Animals' being a bylaw to prohibit or otherwise regulate the keeping of certain animals within the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.
