OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

Council awarded RFP Drinking Water Sampling & Analysis to Ontario Clear Water Agency for water sampling and analysis as required under Ontario Regulation (O. Reg) 319/08 (Small Drinking Water Systems), O. Reg. 169/03 (Ontario Drinking Water Quality Standards), and the *Safe Drinking Water Act*, 2002.



Council passed Bylaw 2021-095 appointing Brandon Northrup as Interim Fire Chief for the Corporation of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands.

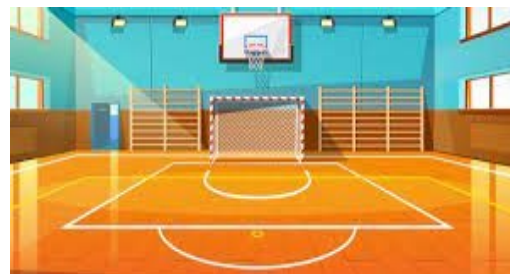
Council passed Bylaw 2021-096 appointing Glen Ackerman as Deputy Fire Chief for the Corporation of the Municipality of Hastings Highlands



2022 User Fees and Service Charges

Council reviewed for first reading "Draft Bylaw 2022-001 User Fees and Service Charges" which sets forth fees for each department. This will come back for second reading on December 1, 2021.

Council accepted the report "Hastings Highlands Community Centre Rentals as per the Ministry of Health Proof of Vaccine Guidance for *Business and Organizations under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*" for information. Council then chose to temporarily close Hastings Highlands Community Centres and Facilities (excluding rentals scheduled during regular business hours at the Hastings Highlands Centre in Emond Hall) until requirements under the *Act* are lifted. We are equipped to provide rentals at Hastings Highlands Centre only at this time.



Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw Amendment Communication to Taxpayers

Council directed staff to add notification of draft amendments to the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw to conform with the County Official Plan into the first tax bill mail out. It will include information about how and when the public can provide comments, feedback or input. This notice will emphasize the opportunity and importance of review and feedback for seasonal residents and shoreline owners
