Does your company transport non-hazardous, solid waste in a company owned vehicle?

You will need to register for the new EASR program by **November 18, 2022**

**Environmental Activity
& Sector Registry (EASR)**

What is a EASR?

- » Tracks less complex, low risk operations
- » Standardizes processes
- » Creates a simpler way to update operations
- » Reduces ECA amendment wait times

Environmental Compliance Approvals (ECAs) for non-hazardous waste transportation systems will cease to apply on November 18, 2022.

A one-time fee will be required to register your company with the EASR program to continue transporting non-hazardous waste



Did You Know?

- » "waste" includes ashes, garbage, refuse, domestic waste, industrial waste
- » Every waste transportation vehicle must be insured under an insurance policy with a minimum coverage of \$2Mil. This includes coverage for liability resulting from possible spills
- » Confirmation of the EASR registration will be required for each vehicle
